Academic Leadership Award

Displays visionary leadership	40%
Demonstrated corporate citizenship and/or community leadership	30%
Demonstrated social impact	30%

Health Champion Award

Demonstrated leadership in advocating for increased use and access to radioisotopes in Canada	60%
Demonstrated social impact	20%
Recognized physician or clinician from a Canadian institution	20%
